

PRIVACY NOTICE

regarding the processing of the personal data of the competitors of the "Mass Race" running event

Budapest 2023 Nonprofit Zrt. (registered seat: 1117 Budapest, Dombóvári út 27. 2. em.; e-mail: adatkezeles@wabudapest23.hu; hereinafter: „**Data Controller**”) is responsible for the preparation organization and management the 2023 WA World Athletics Championship (hereinafter: the “**World Championship**”), in connection with which the Data Controller is organizing a running race event (hereinafter: the “**Race**”) in Budapest on August 27, 2023, in which anyone can attend as a runner. Taking into consideration that entering the Race and ensuring participation requires the processing of personal data, the Data Controller informs the data subjects of the following in accordance with the provisions of the data protection legislation:

3.	Data subjects	Natural persons entering the Race as runners.
4.	Source of personal data	The data subjects or third parties.
5.	Purpose of data processing	Ensuring the completion of tasks related to the organization and conduct of the Race, facilitating on-site organization.
6.	Categories of personal data	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - identification data (name, date of birth, gender, where applicable, nationality), - contact details (phone number, e-mail address), - t-shirt size, - where applicable, additional data provided by the data subject.
7.	Legal basis of data processing	Article 6, paragraph (1) point a) of the GDPR, i.e. the consent of the data subjects, which is given by the data subjects with the nomination as an active behavior. In case of failure to provide data or withdrawal of consent to data processing before the Race, participation in the Race cannot be guaranteed, and in case of withdrawal of consent after the Race, the result achieved in the Race will not be available.
8.	Storing period of personal data	September 30, 2023.

9.	Categories of recipients	<p>World Athletics (seat: 6-8, Quai Antoine 1er, BP 359, MC 98007 Monaco Cedex) World Athletics will only receive name, age, gender, nationality, and email address. The Data Controller will provide precise information on this at the latest at the location of the Race.</p> <p>In addition to the above, the data is known to the employees of the Data Controller who need it to perform their duties.</p>
10.	Rights of the data subjects	<p>The data subject is entitled to the following rights (the conditions of which rights are determined by the governing legislation (e.g. the GDPR)). The data subject can exercise his/her rights by contacting the Data Controller directly via the contact details specified above and precisely specifying exactly what data he/she wishes to exercise his/her rights. 10.1	Right of access	<p>the Data Controller informs the data subject about whether data processing is in progress, and if so, provides related information;</p>
10.2	Right of rectification	<p>if the processed data is inaccurate or incomplete, the Data Controller will correct or supplement it upon request;</p>
10.3	Right to erasure (right to be forgotten)	<p>if the data processing would not be in line of the law, the Data Controller will delete the personal data;</p>
10.4	Right to restriction of processing	<p>In the case of inaccurate, illegal, unnecessary data processing, or if there is an objection against thereof, the Data Controller shall process the data (with the exception of storage) only with the consent of the data subject, or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims or for the protection of the rights of another natural or legal person or for reasons of important public interest of the Union or of a Member State.</p>
10.5.	Right to object	<p>at the request of the data subject, the Data Controller shall no longer process personal data, unless the Data Controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or</p>

Remedies	In the event of a suspected violation of their rights, the data subject may file a complaint with the National Data Protection and Freedom of Information Authority (address: 1055 Budapest, Falk Miksa utca 9-11., phone: +36-1-391-1400, fax: +36-1-391-1410 , e-mail: ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu) or he/she could turn to court. Adjudication of the lawsuit falls within the jurisdiction of the tribunal courts. Description of the technical and organizational measures used to ensure the security of data processing	The necessary and appropriate level of complex information security is ensured by the following measures in terms of confidentiality, integrity and availability: (i) complex administrative and technical protection measures (internal data protection regulations, other mandatory regulations affecting data management), (ii) regular monitoring of data processing processes and continuous customization of protection measures based on continuous risk analysis, as well as a data processing contract with data processors providing adequate guarantees, (iii) personal security measures, (iv)

In the case of a data subject is under the age of 18, the legal representative of the data subject is entitled to make the statement. The Data Controller is entitled to warns the data subject to have his legal representative confirm the granting of data processing consent with a written statement.
